I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all practices and regattas.

I will insist that my child treat other rowers, coaches, volunteers, officials, parents, and spectators with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.

I will help my child enjoy the sport of rowing by doing whatever I can to support Albany Rowing Center, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with regattas, or providing transportation.
